• WHAT IS A BRIDGE BUILDER?

Briefly stated, a Bridge Builder is an individual who is committed to the Bridge Builder ministry of teaching others how to cross God's bridge to eternal life.

• HOW DOES THE BRIDGE BUILDER PROGRAM WORK?

It works using a specific tract as a guide to sharing the gospel in a clear and interesting way. A lapel pin is awarded to those who become involved in the ministry to serve as a conversation starter and to identify that individual as a part of your church's Bridge Builder ministry.

• WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

First of all, evangelism is a command to all believers, and the Bridge Builder ministry encourages obedience to this command. It is designed to keep evangelism alive in your church as well as encourage members with unique outreach opportunities. It is a minimal cost program with a high percentage of involvement and is easily adapted to your church dynamics. The uniqueness and simplicity of this ministry inspires individuals to get involved and last, but not least...IT WORKS!

• HOW DO I GET INVOLVED?

First, share the tract with one person. After this, you will be presented with a Bridge Builder pin which commits you to share that tract on a regular basis with those you come in contact with. If you are not able to share the tract with someone, you can get involved by becoming a Bridge Builder Prayer Partner.
