Philippines: IBCAP Graduations

Berhanu Yoseph, President of East Africa Baptist Mission (pictured second from left in the photo below) traveled to Manila to speak at four of the six graduation exercises at the Independent Baptist College of Asia-Pacific.



IBCAP has experienced significant growth in the last few years and there are now 31 teaching centers with a combined enrollment of nearly 500 students. This year 34 graduates were awarded a Bachelor degree in Bible.

The Carpenter's Project has been privileged to assist Pastor Joselito Avila and a strong Filipino leadership team since the founding of this school in 2010.

Myanmar: Faith Theological College



Rodney traveled to central Myanmar to speak at the graduation at Faith Theological College. He also taught fifteen lessons during a 3-day conference on Servant Leadership, Stewardship, and the Tabernacle.

FTC which began in 2007, has produced more than 50 graduates who are now in full time ministry. Most of the Timothy Project missionaries in Myanmar are graduates of FTC.

Updates on Active Projects

Ethiopia: The translation of *Biblical Basis for Baptists* into Amharic is nearly complete. We could send it to the printers this month, but we still need \$2,400 to make an initial printing of 2,000 copies.



Philippines: The construction of the dining hall at Baptist Heritage Bible School is underway. This is a \$6,000 project, and we need only \$1,000 more to fully fund the improvements.

Myanmar: The three church buildings in Rakhine State are fully funded and are now under construction. Thank you for giving to these needy people.



Haiti: The video backpack unit for the Haitian Evangelist was purchased and Rodney will take it with him to Gonaives in April.

We have \$700 but need \$400 more to purchase property for the mission church at Lakou.

A Final Word

Rodney will be in Haiti the first two weeks of April to minister in churches and in the Bible school. There will be an ordination service of a few pastors. Please pray for his health and safety.
