June 2019 Prayer Letter

Dear Praying Friends,

In the last week of March, we started 8 weeks of English classes. The goal was not to teach English, but a way to serve the community and share the gospel with students. We saw over 50 people come to at least one class and we had 14 graduate. We held our last class on June 1st and our graduation on the Sunday morning of June 2nd. It was a great service and the gospel was preached. Even though we saw no one come to Christ yet from these classes, we were able to make friends and have several students return for a service and few that are attending regularly now. One of those who are attending is a young man who is not saved. Please be praying for him.

On June 9th, we had a Men's Fellowship. It went very well and we had an incredible turnout. The Lord is really working in the lives of our men. Please continue to pray for the men of Iglesia Bautista Fe and that some young men would surrender their lives to preach the gospel.

Last August, I met a young man named Lemuel and we have been praying for him ever since. He is lost and I have been burdened for him as of late. I have a meeting with him this Friday and I am hoping for an opportunity to clearly share the gospel with him. Would you please pray this way with me?

Also, in May, I met a man from Nigeria in the street in front of the church. There are many African nationals in Buenos Aires and the majority speak Spanish. When I spoke to him, I could tell he didn't understand and I thought it was due to my accent, but I discovered that he doesn't speak Spanish. We were able to talk for a minute in English. His name is Alex and just moved to Argentina a few months ago looking for a different opportunity. I invited him to church and he came to a service. I am hoping to see him again and I am praying for another opportunity to witness to Alex. We talked briefly about salvation but I am not sure that he is saved.

- Father's Day Service: We having a special service this Sunday. Please be praying for this event.
- Language School: I'm in the last few weeks of Language school and my Spanish is improving each day. Please be praying for the last few weeks of class. I still have a long way to go but I know with hard work and faith I will get there.
