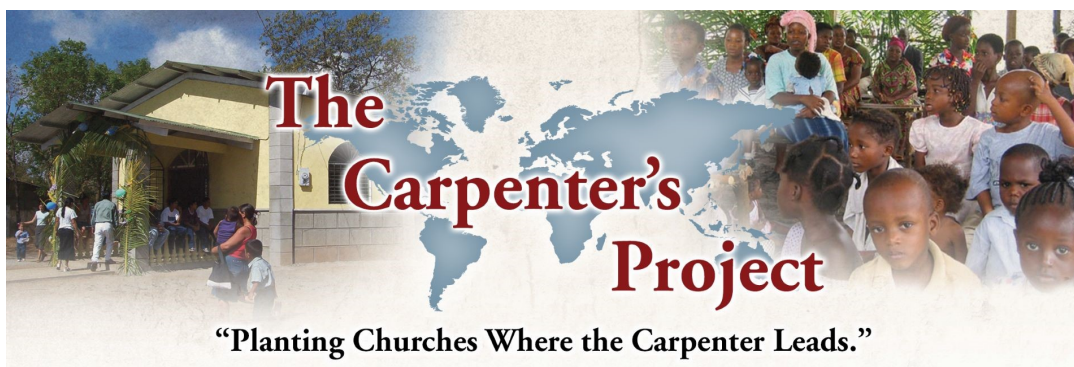

Vietnam: Obeying God not Man

On July 31, Rodney was in Ho Chi Minh City ministering in an underground/illegal assembly during their midweek service.



Rodney said, *"It is exciting to hear testimonies of how the members are establishing relationships with unbelievers in their communities, having opportunities to share the Gospel, and seeing souls saved."*

One morning he spoke in a chapel service to the students of an international English school that, though it is a Christian ministry, cannot use the

word 'Christian' in its name.

Then he traveled with the same church group to a location where they held a 2-day family camp retreat. He was asked to bring three messages during the retreat and there were many decisions by the members to deal with sin in their lives and seek a closer walk with the Lord.



Before returning to the US, Rodney will be traveling throughout Vietnam to visit ministries in three other cities - as far north as Hanoi. This will involve four flights and some road trips. Please pray for Rodney's safety in travel and for the services to see unbelievers respond to the Gospel and Christians edified.

Siang Ve is the newest Timothy project missionary to Rakhine State, Myanmar. Here is his testimony:
