## **October 2019 Prayer Letter**

Dear praying friends,

During the month of September, my family and I celebrated two years on the field here in Argentina. So much has changed in last 2 years and through language school and the transition into the culture here, we have seen the Lord increase our faith and trust in Him. He is faithful and we feel honored to serve Him here in this great country.

In September, I began discipleship with a man named Nazareno, He is about 40 years old and was saved several years ago in another ministry and is now wanting to know more about the Bible and grow in the Lord. We have had several good meetings and it is exciting to see his eagerness to grow.

Also in September, I started preaching 5 to 10 minute messages before our Saturday outreach. It is great practice for my language growth and each time my Spanish gets better. It is not an easy or comfortable thing but I am grateful to have the opportunity to preach.

Also, we recently started a Bible college and now we have two students! Right now we are learning Principals of Bible study. Both young men are excelling and growing in the their desire to serve the Lord.

This past month we have seen two ladies and one man believe on Jesus as their personal savior. One of the ladies is 71 years old and has been attending services for about 2 months. She has told us that the Lord is working in her family and since trusting Christ, she has been burdened for her family, especially her husband Rueben. He is a local handyman and has helped us in several ways since the church moved into their new building 9 months ago. Please be in prayer for Rueben, Clara and their family.

Finally, in September we had our first family conference. It was an excellent time and enjoyed by all. We had guest speakers from other churches throughout Argentina in attendance. During the conference we also had a couple's fellowship and our annual Family Picture day. All in all, the Lord used the conference greatly and we are praying that God continues to work in the lives of these young believers.
